



**USER GUIDE FOR THE ORGANET REGISTRATION
SYSTEM FOR THE ILS TECHNICAL OFFICIALS AT
THE LIFESAVING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS
ADELAIDE 2018**

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User Guide for the OrgaNet Registration system

This guide will show you how to register yourself into the OrgaNet Registration system as a Technical Official at the Lifesaving World Championships Adelaide 2018 (LWC 2018). **Please read through it carefully to ensure that you understand the steps that you need to take to successfully complete the Registration process.** You must first apply for an account with OrgaNet (if you don't already have one) before registering as a Technical Official.

Preparation information

Before you begin to take any action to register, please note the following important information:

1. You must complete your registration by **16th July 2018**. Your registration will also serve as an acknowledgement that you accept the Technical Officials role(s) to which you have been appointed for the LWC 2018 events.
2. For ILS Technical Officials there is no charge for using the Registration system which will be used to print your Security Accreditation tag (with photograph) that will be necessary to enable you to access the transport provided to the competition venues, Technical Official areas, competition areas, hospitality areas, Technical Official social functions and access to any public transport that is provided in the Glenelg/Adelaide area.
3. If you are attending the LWC 2018 events with a partner/spouse/family member(s) who is not an appointed Technical Officials, they will need to register separately using the Accompanying Persons Registration system (information on how to do that is provided at the end of this guide). For all persons registered through the Accompanying Persons registration system there will be a 10 Euro fee charged to cover the costs of providing their Security Accreditation Tag (with photograph). This tag will be required for entry into all spectator and hospitality areas, and to access any public transport that is provided.
4. You may not know all of the details regarding your air travel or accommodation at the time of registration. However, you can return to it whenever required to provide that information subsequently, using your login details.
5. [Privacy Information](#) - The ILS is committed to ensuring that the personal data we collect is kept securely and only used for the purpose for which it is collected. If you register as a Delegate, Technical Official or Accompanying Person, the ILS may be required to transfer your personal data to a host organisation that is not within the EU. We need your consent for this. An individual can withdraw that consent at any time by contacting the ILS. A privacy notice with further information is available through a link in the registration process.

The Registration Process

The Registration process takes you through the following three steps:

1. **Step 1 – Application for your account with the OrgaNet Registration system** (unless you are already registered in the system) – self-administered and authorised by **your approval** of an e-mail sent to your e-mail address. If you have already set up your account with OrgaNet there is no need to apply for another account and you can start at Step 2. However, if you have never set up an OrgaNet account you must begin at Step 1.
2. **Step 2 – Registration of your attendance at the LWC 2018 events as an ILS Technical Official** – this will be done automatically within the OrgaNet system.

3. **Step 3 – Completion of your registration**, including your acceptance of the role(s) to which you have been appointed, the booking of items such as transport from Adelaide Airport and return, your Security Accreditation Tag, and attendance at the ILS Technical Officials social functions.
4. If you are attending the 2018 events with a partner/spouse/other family member(s), the process for using the Accompanying Persons Registration system is covered in this guide immediately after this.

Icons commonly used in OrgaNet



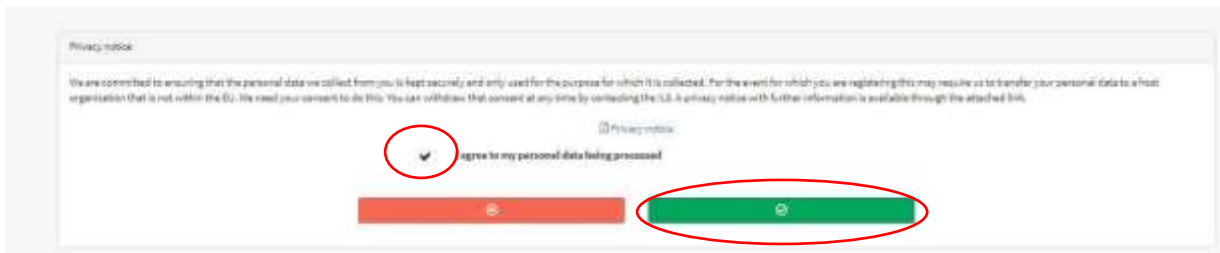
Help: You can access the user guide relevant to your event whenever you see this sign. The Help button on the left-hand menu of the Home Screen will take you to the general guide for applying for an OrgaNet account



Submit Registration: Only use this icon when you wish to submit a registration. Do not use it to amend a registration already submitted (use the Edit icon instead)



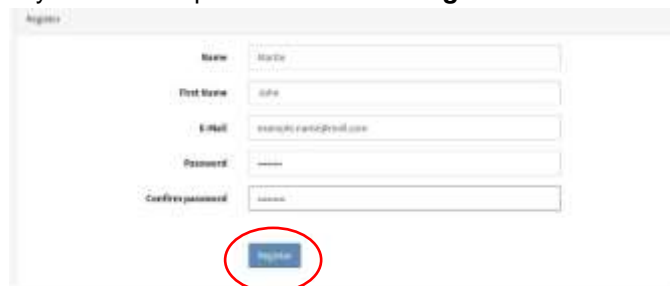
Edit: Use this icon to edit/update/amend your registration, including adding competitors to events



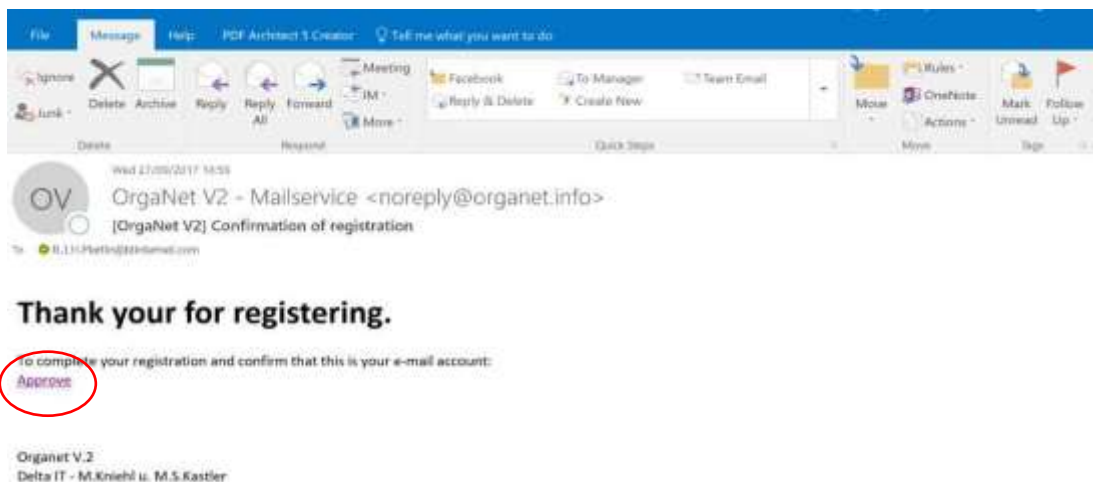
If you choose not to give consent, click on the red box. A message window will appear to ask if you are sure. Click on OK and your application for an OrgaNet account will cease.



Once you have selected the green box, an account window will open. Apply for an account by inserting your last name in the **Name** field, your first name in the **First Name** field, and the e-mail address you wish to use for this account, select a password of your choice, and confirm the password where indicated. It is very important that you ensure that the e-mail address you type into this account application window is correct as this is the address that the system will respond to. Click on **Register**.



In response you will receive an e-mail from noreply@organet.info



The response from OrgaNet should be received quite quickly. If you do not receive it, take the following action:

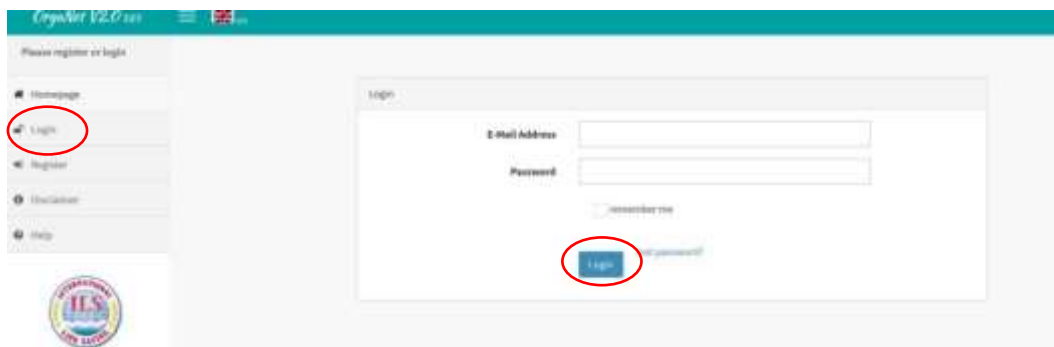
1. Check your spam folder, in case it has been received there.
2. Contact the ILS OrgaNet Administrator by e-mail at j.martin@ilsf.org to advise when you submitted your account registration, and confirm the e-mail address you used. Use the heading “**OrgaNet Account Application Approval e-mail not received**” in your e-mail.
3. The ILS OrgaNet Administrator will investigate and provide you with a response as soon as practically possible.
4. You may be requested to submit a new account registration to resolve it, but only do this if requested.

When you have received the necessary e-mail from OrgaNet, click on the link to **Approve**

You will then receive a message back from OrgaNet to confirm that your account registration has been successful. This message may well be in German, regardless of the user language you have selected. Click **OK**.



You will then need to log in and complete your profile to complete the Account Application process. Click on **Login** on the left side of the screen, complete your e-mail address and password and click on the **Login** button:



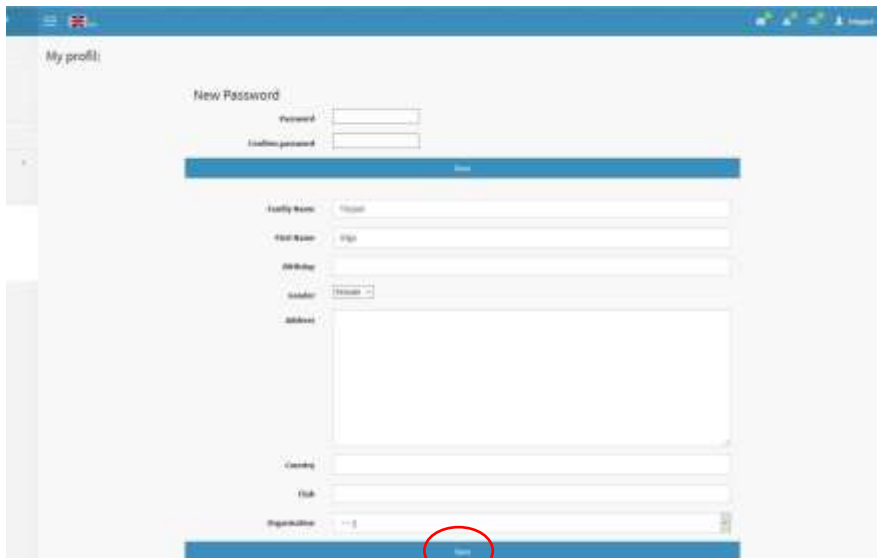
You will receive a “Login successful” message:



Click **OK**, then go to your name on the top right hand corner, click open the account name, then click on **Profile** to complete your details.

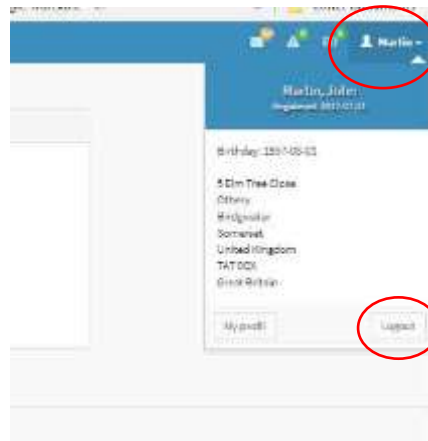
When entering your **BirthDay** you **must** use this format – yyyy-mm-dd





You can always return to this screen at any time to amend your details and change your password if you wish. Click on **Save** and your account application action is complete.

You now need to submit your registration as an ILS Technical Official. You can do this later if you wish, but in order to proceed, you should first logout of the system by selecting your name in the right hand top corner, then clicking on **Logout**.



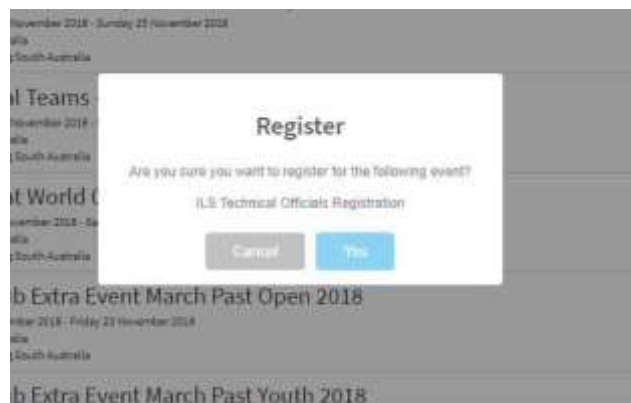
2. Registration as an ILS Technical Official with the OrgaNet system

Log into OrgaNet using your new **Login** details and you will see the opening page showing all of the events at the LWC 2018.

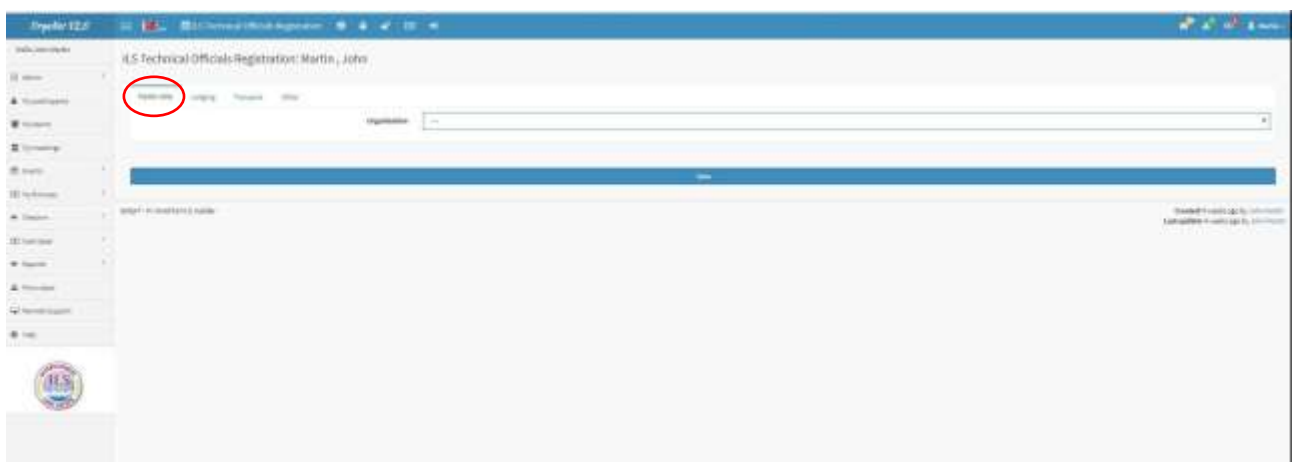


Select the **ILS Technical Officials** Registration system by Clicking on this icon on the right hand side of the screen: ➡

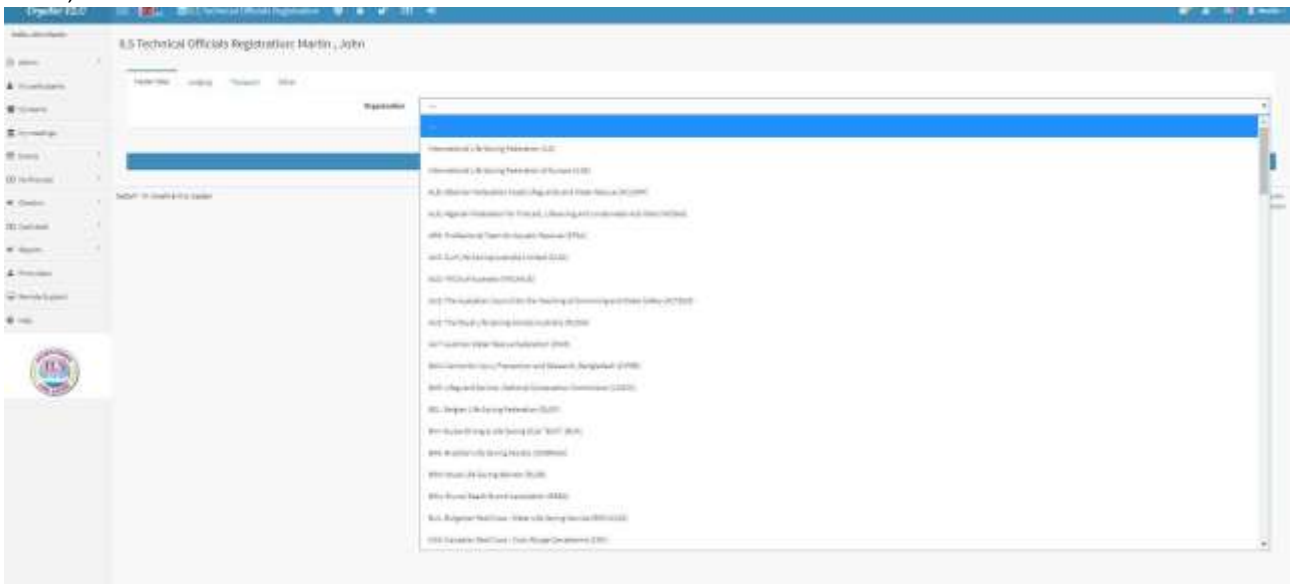
When you select this event you will get a message to ask if you are sure you want to register for the ILS Technical Officials Registration:



Click on **Yes** to proceed. Your registration will be automatically approved in the system and your screen should now show the **Registration** window set to the **Master Data** tab:



In the **Organisation** box, select your National Federation from the list of drop-down options. See **Appendix 1** for details of your Federation’s name as shown in OrgaNet (it is arranged in order of the IOC Country Code):



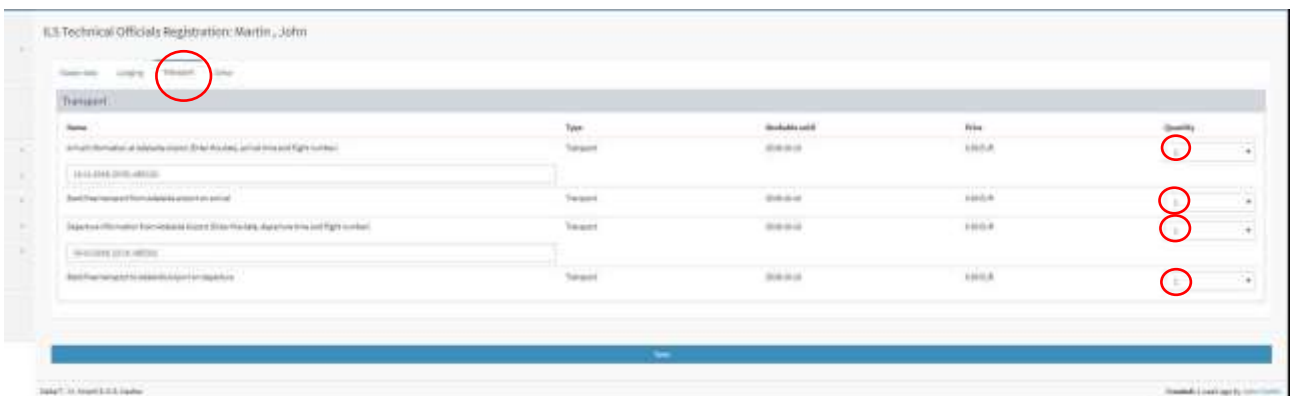
Next click on the **Lodging** Tab.

In the box provided please enter the address of the Accommodation where you will be staying while at the LWC 2018 events (so that transport arrangements can be co-ordinated).



Ensure that you change the **Quantity** drop down from 0 to 1, otherwise your information will not be retained even if you click **Save**. If you do not yet know where you will be staying, please leave this blank. You can return to this at any time to provide the information when it is known.

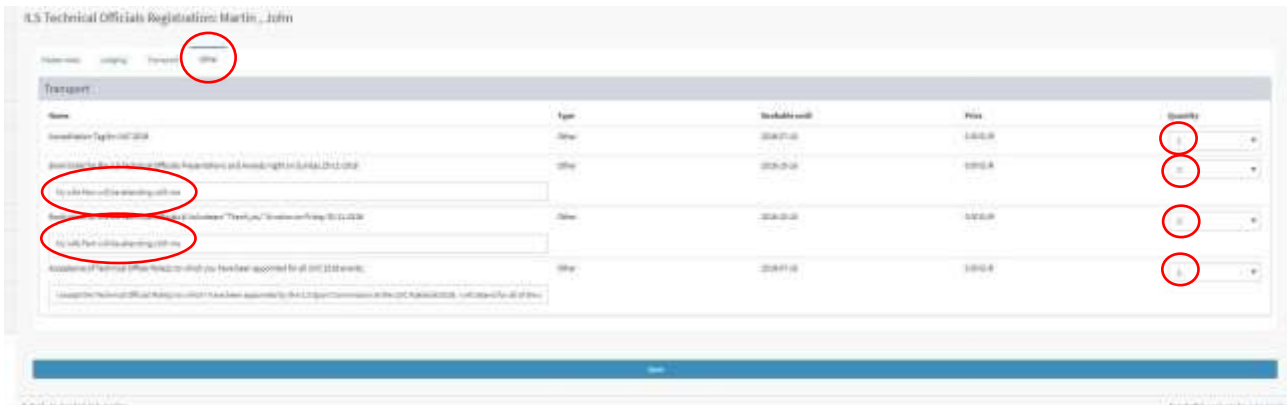
Next, click on the **Transport** Tab



Provide the information required to give details of your Arrival and Departure at Adelaide Airport, and book your transport to and from the Airport. If you do not yet know when you will arrive and depart, please leave

this blank. You can return to this at any time to provide the information when it is known. Remember to change the **Quantity** value from 0 to 1 for all items selected.

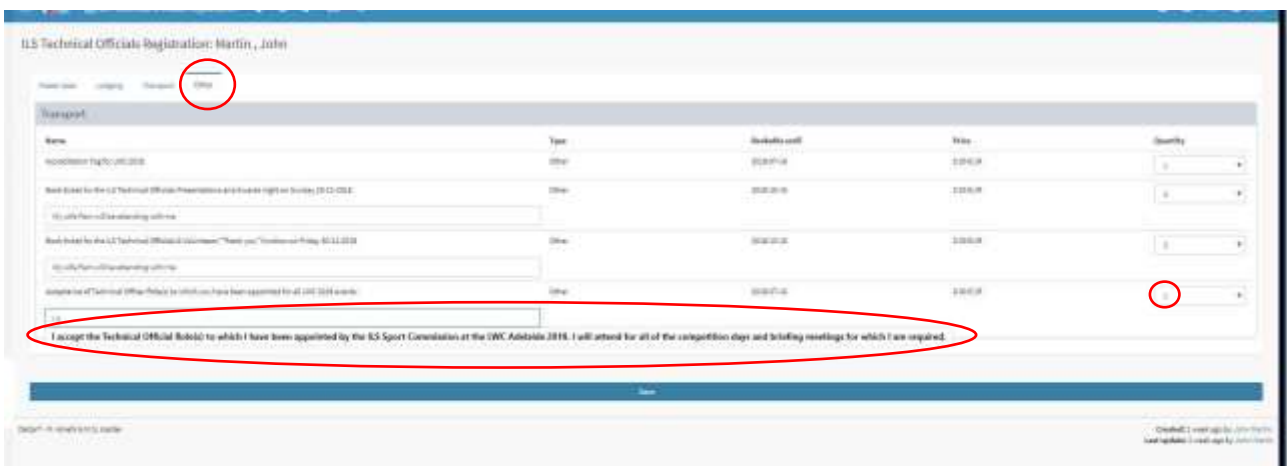
Click on the **Other** Tab



Order your Accreditation Tag as an ILS Technical Official, and also book your place at the ILS Technical Officials social functions – the Awards and Presentation Night on Sunday 25th November and the Officials and Volunteers Thank You function on Friday 30th November (if appropriate). If you are bringing your partner/spouse with you to these functions change the **Quantity** from 0 to the required number and insert their details where indicated.

Finally, ensure you complete the final item on the Other Tab to confirm your acceptance of the role(s) to which you have been appointed at LWC 2018. The wording to insert here is:

I accept the Technical Official role(s) to which I have been appointed by the ILS Sport Commission at the LWC Adelaide 2018. I will attend for all of the competition days and briefing meetings for which I am required.



As soon as you begin typing "I accept..." the wording should appear beneath and you can simply select that. Change the Quantity value from 0 to 1.


Complete your registration action by clicking on **Save**.

After saving OrgaNet will show the following screen showing a **Teams** Tab selected:



Click on the **Participant** Tab at the top of the screen to show your current registration.



If you need to make further amendments or want to check the information you have submitted just use the **Actions** icon on the right hand side, then **Save** your information again: 

You can now **logout** of OrgaNet.


3. Amending your registration/adding information at a later date

IMPORTANT NOTE: If at a future date/time you wish to make further amendments or add information that you did not have previously, when you login to OrgaNet, **do not select the registration icon on the right-hand side of the screen because it will automatically submit a duplicate registration.**



Instead select **My Meetings** from the left-hand side menu options to bring up the screen showing your registration.



On the right hand side of the screen click on the **Actions** icon: 

This will then bring up your **Registration** window and you can continue to make whatever amendments to the saved information that you wish by click on the appropriate tab at the top.

Remember to **Save** before you exit and **logout**.

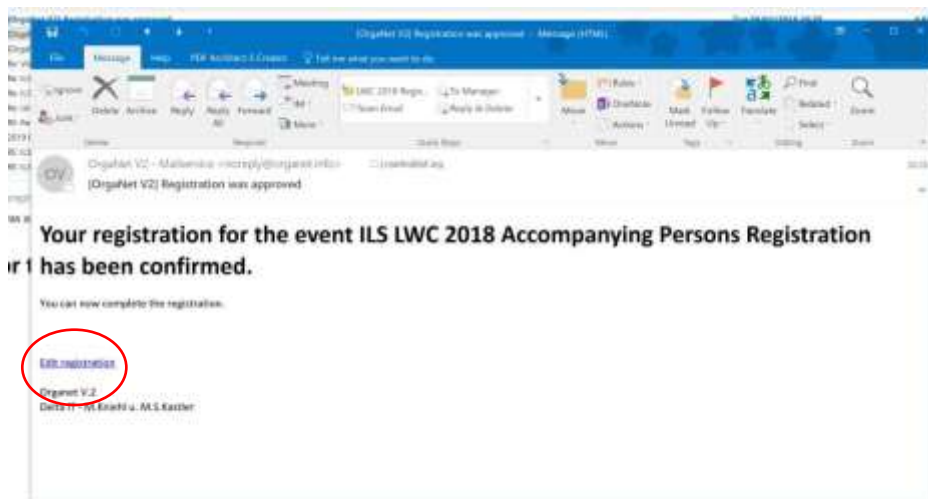
4. Registration as an Accompanying Person with the OrgaNet system

If you are attending the LWC 2018 events with your partner/spouse and/or other family members, they **must** use the Accompanying Persons Registration system to register and pay for their Accreditation. Use the same link to access OrgaNet: <https://ils.organet.info>

The process for applying for an account for the OrgaNet is the same as described in Section 1, pages 2 to 4. Your partner/spouse/family member should apply for their own account using that process. Once they have an account, they can then register for the Accompanying Persons Registration by clicking on the registration icon for this system as shown below:



After submitting their request for registration, your Accompanying Person should receive a confirmation e-mail



They can then click on the **Edit Registration** link shown in the e-mail. They will be prompted to log in and it will take them back to the opening screen. They should then select **My Meetings** from the left-hand side menu options. This will bring up the screen showing their registration.



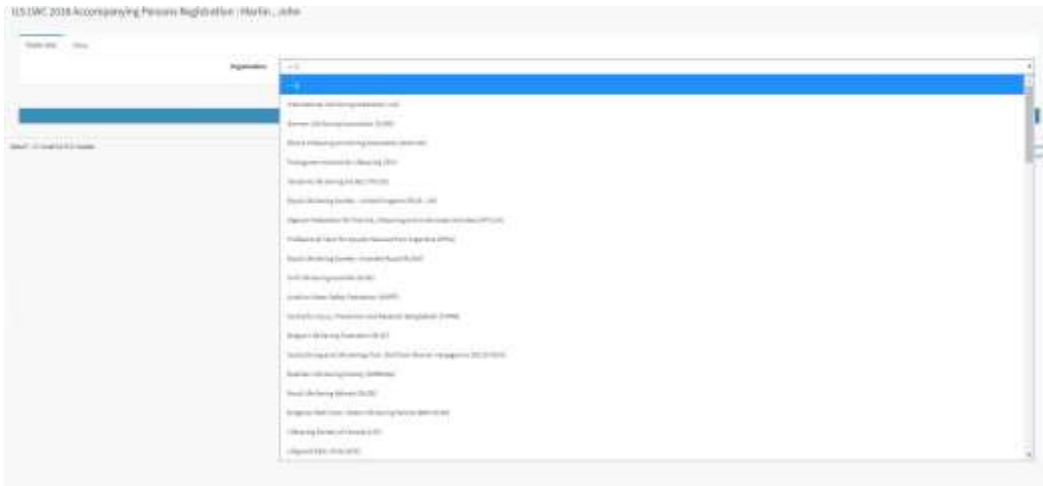
On the right hand side of the screen they should click on the **Actions** icon:



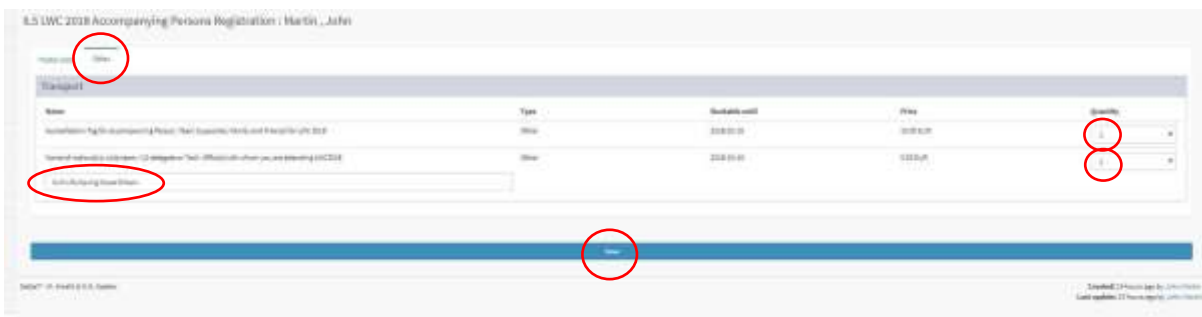
The **Edit Registration** window will open set to the **Master Data** tab.



In the **Organisation** box, the Accompanying Person should select the National Federation of the ILS Technical Official whom they are accompanying from the list of drop-down options. See **Appendix 1** for details of the full list of National Federations and their abbreviation:



They must then click on the **Other** Tab



They can then order their Accreditation Tag as an Accompanying Person, Team Supporter, Family and Friends for LWC 2018, by changing the **Quantity** value from 0 to 1.

They should then provide the name of ILS Technical Official with whom they are attending LWC 2018 where indicated, and change the **Quantity** value from 0 to 1 to ensure the data is retained.

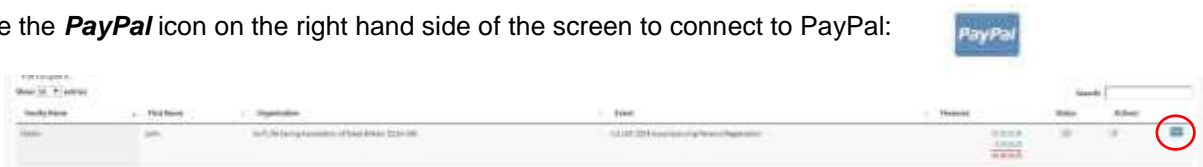
Finally, they should click on **Save** to complete their registration as an Accompanying Person.

5. Payment for the Accompanying Persons Accreditation

Having submitted their registration for Accreditation, the **My Meetings** window will reopen and they can proceed to the payment for their Security Accreditation Tag – the cost is 10 Euro.

They will need a **PayPal** account to be able to make a payment. This will normally be connected to a personal e-mail address when set up. However, it may be that, rather than using your personal account to make payment, you will be using a national federation account or club account, in which case you will need to know the e-mail address it is linked to and the password and use those details.

Use the **PayPal** icon on the right hand side of the screen to connect to PayPal:



Follow the **PayPal** login process and continue to the payment authorisation. Once you or they have authorised the payment it will revert back to OrgaNet with confirmation that the payment was successful.

The Accompanying Persons Registration action is now complete and you/they can log out of OrgaNet.

On arrival at the LWC 2018, both you and your Accompanying Person(s) should go to the **Accreditation Centre in Glenelg** (located immediately behind Glenelg Surf Life Saving Club) and **Check-In** – your photograph will be taken and a Security Accreditation Tag will be provided for you to wear when attending any LWC 2018 event.
